

Dental Services Eligible for Discount

Patient Direct members receive at least 20% off dental services and treatments provided in-office by an Arizona Patient Direct dentist. The chart below outlines the broad classifications of dental procedures eligible for this discount. When seeking treatment from a Patient Direct dentist, you may ask for the CDT code(s) of the proposed procedure(s) to verify they are eligible for a discount.
