Q: What is the best dental advice you've ever received?

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

2024 ADA DENTAL CLAIM FORM IS LIVE

Effective January 1, 2024, the latest version of the American Dental Association's claim form went live with updates that help streamline dental claims processing, including last scaling and root planing dates, payer ID fields and more. You can access a fillable PDF of the 2024 ADA Dental Claim Form by signing into the Dental Office Toolkit (DOT) at <u>deltadentalaz.com/dentist</u>.

4 Tips to Make Reading Your Faxback Easier

With so much information on the faxback, trying to find the information you need quickly can sometimes be overwhelming. Here are the locations of 4 frequently requested items:

- 1. Crowns that have an alternate benefit: Located under Major Restorative and is a bullet point after procedure codes
- 2. Posterior composites covered or alternate benefit: Located under Minor Restorative and is a bullet point after procedure codes
- **3.** Last Date of Service for Preventive and Diagnostic services: Located on first page of fax under Office Visit (however will only provide dates of history if not eligible for services)
- 4. **Currently Eligible/Active:** Located on the upper left of the first page titled Currently Eligible with yes or no as of date

Documentation Required for Claims

As a reminder, it's important to ensure that you're including everything we need to process dental claims quickly. We have a <u>processing policy lookup tool</u> on our website and within the Dental Office Toolkit that will allow you to double-check processing policies and confirm what documentation is required. In particular, there are two CDT codes with documentation requirements that we'd like to highlight:

Code D9997: Dental Case Management - Patients with Special Health Care Needs

We're pleased to see many of our Delta Dental of Arizona dentists treating special health care needs patients since we introduced our Special Health Care Needs dental benefit. Just a quick reminder: **when you submit a D9997 code, make sure to include the qualifying condition on the claim form**—either in the **remarks section** or as an **attached narrative.** We'll verify this information during our review.

Code D6010: Surgical Placement of Implant Body; Endosteal Implant

Pre and post operative radiographs of diagnostic quality are necessary for consideration of implant benefits on a claim. X-rays should include the sites directly mesial and distal to the implant, including the root apices when those teeth are present. Note: Panos are ok unless there is perceived pathology at one or both neighboring sites. In those instances, additional and more diagnostic X-rays would be requested.
